

Cold Weather Tips for Pets During Winter:



Keep a disaster supply kit with supplies your pet would need in an emergency.



Antifreeze is lethal poison for dogs & cats. Clean up any vehicle spills.



During deep snows, shovel out a potty spot for your dog.



Use pet friendly ice melt so pets do not ingest harmful salt and other chemicals.



Keep cats & small housepets inside. They can freeze, become lost or injured outdoors.



Never leave pets in a car, which can act as a refrigerator during cold weather.



Provide a warm place to sleep - off of the floor and away from drafts.



Puppies & senior dogs are more sensitive to cold so limit exposure.



Short-haired pets benefit from coats & booties.



Clip fur between toe pads to reduce snow & ice collection.
